What is a fellowship?

- An extra period of study to deepen knowledge and understanding
- Usually 3-12 months
- Different department, region, country
- Usually in a specialist centre









ESOR-ESPR fellowship – 1 year

- Available to radiologists who are ESR members
- Within 3 years of certification
- Be eligible to work in the EU
- Must have adequate local language skills (or English)
- A valid COVD-19 vaccination certificate



ESOR-ESPR fellowship

- Currently 3 options available:
- o Paediatric Radiology, 1 year Kremlin Bicêtre, France
- o Paediatric and Fetal Imaging, 1 year Robert Debré, France
- o Paediatric Imaging, 1 year Ioannina, Greece

> Grants vary per institute – please check carefully!



How to apply

- Select your interest
- Complete the application form, which includes:
 An up-to-date CV
 Letter of recommendation
 Proof of certification









ESOR-ESPR fellowship —3 months

- Available to radiologists who are ESR members
- Within 3 years of certification
- Be eligible to work in the EU
- Must have adequate local language skills (or English)
- A valid COVD-19 vaccination certificate

- > Grant total of 3500 euro, subject to terms and conditions




